HOW DO I SPONSOR A TREE? Registration is easy and can be done online at:

WHERE WILL TREES BE DISPLAYED? Trees will be displayed at the Earle May Boat Basin in Bainbridge and will be an extension of *Lights Along the River*.

HOW & WHEN CAN I SELECT MY TREE? Please visit the Chamber building on Tuesday, Nov. 21 at 8 AM to pick up your sign and select your spot. (*first come, first serve*)

WILL SOMEONE CHECK MY TREE FOR OUTAGES, FALLEN ORNAMENTS, AND DAMAGE? It is recommended that you check your tree periodically. Please remember the trees are out in the elements for over 30 days, and wind, rain, or other weather may cause ornaments or the tree to fall. The Chamber is not responsible for any lost or damaged decorations or trees.



Decorating Information



DECATORING DAY: November 21 - 24

SUPPLIES TO BRING: LED lights ONLY. No exceptions. Extension cord must be an outdoor extension cord at least 25 ft. long . Decorations must be able to withstand outdoor conditions, wind and rain. Zip-ties, pipe cleaners, string or other ties to secure your decorations are recommended. We suggest purchasing a spotlight (*electrical or solar*) for additional lighting at night.

STAKING YOUR TREE: You will be responsible for staking your tree to prevent it from falling. We recommend wood, rebar, or metal stakes no longer than 12 inches. We wouldn't want you to drive a stake into underground electricity, so keep it under 12 inches. Please bring string or wire or string to secure your tree to the stakes.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE PARK: A check-in table will be set up with a Representative or volunteer at the Chamber of Commerce. You will receive your sign upon check-in and "claim" your spot. BRING YOUR LIGHTS.

UNDECORATING YOUR TREE: JANUARY 2 - 3 | Sponsors are responsible for undecorating their tree between the dates listed above. If a sponsor fails to undecorate their tree, the decorations will be thrown away.
